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**Labor Day Camping Trip at Harrington Beach State Park**

*Friday, September 1 - Monday, September 4*

The annual Labor Day camping trip will be at Harrington Beach State Park this year. Only 35 miles north of Milwaukee off Highway 43 near Belgium, this park has one mile of scenic Lake Michigan shoreline to explore and short hiking trails within the park. The surrounding area has great kayaking, hiking, and biking opportunities. Come for all three nights, or just one or two. Vehicles must have an annual state park sticker or day pass. There is limited parking in the group camp area.

The group campsite has drinking water and a pit toilet, and it's a short walk to shower facilities in the family campground. Nightly campfires will be held. Camping trip cost is only \$14 per person (non-members \$15.50). Please make checks payable to NSCM and mail to Mary Mueller, 4862 North Shoreland Avenue, Milwaukee, WI, 53217, along with your

email address, for the trip letter in late August. There are only 30 spots, so plan to join us for end-of-summer fun.
