Keweenaw Peninsula Ski Trip

Friday, December 30 - Monday, January 2

Ring in the New Year with your friends and enjoy great skiing in the Keweenaw Peninsula of Upper Michigan. We will leave Friday morning at 8 am and stop to ski at Brown County Reforestation Camp near Green Bay or Afterglow near Phelps. Swedetown has 30 km of groomed trails and a ski chalet with snack bar. Michigan Tech University has 35 km of superbly groomed trails that are very wide, and there is a chalet as well as a small warming hut. Both areas have snowshoe trails. Maasto Hiito has 24 km of scenic, striding-only trails. Accommodations are at the Super 8 Motel in Houghton, MI with swimming pool, whirlpool, sauna, and free continental breakfast.
