(There are restrooms available at the maintenance bldg. north of the parking lot).</p> <p>The main nature center/planetarium will not be open until 6:30 pm. Displays may be open for us but this is not definite yet. The planetarium will open for us at 7pm where we can hold a short business meeting, with the program "Winter Sky Legends" to follow at 7:15-8:15. The club will cover the cost of the program.</p> <p>Check their website for details, a map, and directions as it varies depending where you're coming from. If you're taking I-94 west, exit at Cty TT (exit 291) and go south about 1.8 miles to Hwy 18 (Summit Ave). Turn right on Hwy 18 and go a little over 1 mile to Cty DT. Turn left and go south to Madison St., then turn left and go a short distance to the park entrance. Lapham Peak Trail Clearing
Saturday, November 11, 9:00 am until noon

On Saturday, November 11, the Nordic Ski Club will be working with the Friends of Lapham Peak to trim bushes, pick rocks and spread wood chips on the ski trails in preparation for the winter ski season. We will start at 9 am at the Hausmann Nature Center parking lot (the parking lot just before the tower parking lot). Please bring a garden rake, lopper, pruner, shovel or pitch fork, and appropriate footwear and work gloves. After the work is completed around noon, a chili lunch will be provided by Friends of Lapham Peak. Bring a dessert, bread or another item to share.

Directions: To get to Lapham Peak, go west on I-94 and take the Delafield, Cty Hwy C exit. Proceed south for one mile on Cty C, the park entrance is on the left (east) side of Hwy C. A state park sticker is needed for your vehicle to enter the park. A daily park sticker costs \$8. Please contact Rita Keber at rkeber@milwpc.com or 262-547-4827 to let her know you are coming.

Glacier Hills County Park Hike

Hike Glacier Hills County Park with fellow Nordics. There are multiple trails of varying lengths on this moderately hilly terrain. DIRECTIONS: Take Hwy 41/45 north to 167 WEST (Holy Hill Road; please be aware that 167 East is Mequon Road; 167 West is several miles past this). Go west on 167, then south on Friess Lake Road (if you get to Holy Hill, you've gone too far). The park entrance is less than a mile, on the left. There are several parking lots. Drive on the main curvy road until there is a large building directly in front of you. The parking lot is on the left.
